Respite Care Connection (RCC) is a specialized program for children and youth who would benefit from time with their peers in a small group of 6-9 youth. We use both indoor and outdoor spaces around our clubhouse, community spaces such as parks, and recreation facilities for swimming, bowling, and much more.

RCC specializes in strengthening participants' self-esteem, skill development, and socialization skills through a fun and safe environment with a ratio of one staff to three youth. Youth must be able to be successful in this ratio and not require 1:1 support.

All staff are trained in safety, risk management, emotional regulation strategies, and Standard First Aid/CPR.

RCC (Respite Care Connection) is a specialized program that fosters learning vital life skills such as cooking, exploring, friendship and healthy habits in a small group of 6-9 youth with a 3:1 staff ratio.
